This quarterly lecture will review the current science and promising practices regarding the emerging use of smart phone technology and its application in treatment engagement, client retention, and ongoing recovery support. Dr. Glasner-Edwards will begin by presenting initial findings from a research project focusing on the development of a text message treatment intervention application that targets medication adherence and relapse prevention among opioid users with HIV. Next, Dr. Gonzales will present on a mixed method approach to developing and evaluating a mobile-based continuing care intervention for substance abusing youth who are transitioning into recovery.

Following the presentation portion of the lecture, Dr. Gonzales will moderate a community treatment panel. The panelists will provide their perspectives regarding the real world implications of using promising smart phone technologies to engage clients in treatment and provide ongoing recovery support.
